The Malki Foundation's mission is to empower the parents of children with severe disabilities, allowing them the freedom to choose the paramedical therapies and therapists best suited to their child's needs.

## WHAT IS A MALKI FOUNDATION PATRON?

## WHY IS IT NEEDED?

Israel has approximately 65,000 children with severe special needs. Much of the needed therapy is not covered by Israeli health care or social services.

For more than a decade and a half, The Malki Foundation has been Israel's dominant source of empowerment for families who choose homecare for their child with special-needs. Since our establishment in 2001, we have alleviated physical and financial hardships for more than 4,000 families by facilitating about 45,000 hours of paramedical therapies and more than 3,000 long-term equipment loans. Unfortunately, despite all of our accomplishments to date, there are still many more children in need of these essential services.

We are very proud of our work, our staff, and the families we help, but there are many children that still need our help.

We receive daily requests to help children and our current waiting list has 80 children on it.

To provide these children with weekly therapy for a year will cost an additional £120,000 per year and whilst we do all we can to keep our administrative costs to a minimum, our funds are not sufficient to be able to cover all of our facilities, projects and plans.

# WHERE WILL MY SUPPORT GO TO?

The Malki Foundation has three programmes, **Therapies at Home**, **Therapists on Wheels** and the **Children's Equipment Lending Library (CELL)**.

Through Therapies at Home, the Malki Foundation subsidizes the cost of the five most important non-medical therapies: physical, horse, water, speech, occupational.

Once accepted to the program, the parents work independently with the therapist in order to achieve the best outcome for their child. The family is given an annual budget, which on average amounts to 6 therapy sessions a month per child

Through the Therapists on Wheels program, the Malki Foundation provides mobile therapists who travel to where the children with special-needs live, delivering quality paramedical therapies – physical, speech and occupational therapy. The entire cost of the service, including travel, is covered by the Malki Foundation.

The Children's Equipment Lending Library (CELL), in partnership with Alyn Hospital Paediatric and Adolescent Rehabilitation Center in Jerusalem will lend specialised assistive equipment that are designed and adjusted specifically to meet the needs of children with disabilities. Our CELL will lend out specialized equipment for free for as long as the child needs it.

Once returned, the equipment is refurbished and then lent out to the next child who is in need. On average, almost 150 children per year require specialized equipment upon discharge in order to continue treatment and be able to participate more independently in daily life activities. Upon completion, the CELL will contain over 50 pieces of equipment of all types and sizes, including, walkers, standers, bathroom systems, activity chairs, specialized strollers, and wheelchairs.
